Senior Andrew Liu is the only Cav with previous experience in this event as he made his 3<sup>rd</sup> appearance at the Granger. Having been to the event over the years as coaches however, we have developed a solid game plan on how to attack these two courses.

The Hills Course at 6577 yards is one of the shortest venues that we will play all year, but it certainly played different than we'd ever seen due to the tough conditions. We work hard in practice to develop mental toughness as we constantly challenge the kids to become comfortable being uncomfortable. Over the past few weeks we

have challenged the kids to continue to practice during the afternoons showers we've had (when safe of course) to prepare them for this situation exactly, and it paid off handsomely. We have worked hard on our short games and they must continue to improve, additionally we have got to hit more greens with wedges. 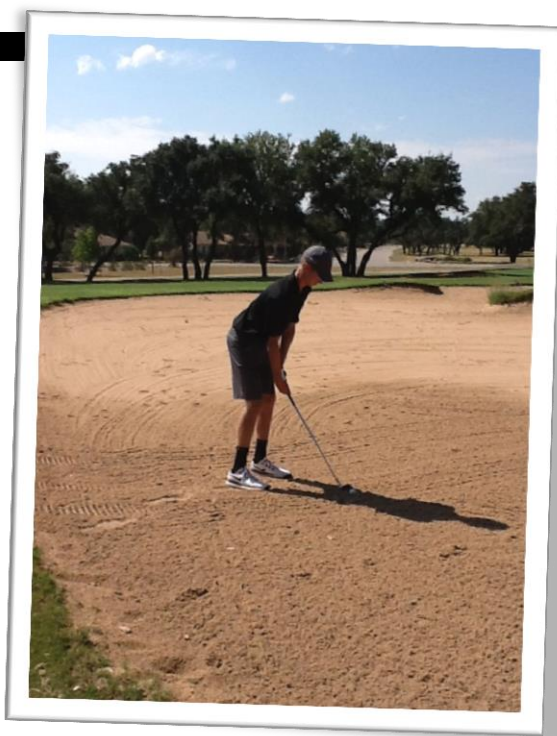
