Kristen Gillman, the LT lineup featured Sophomores Veronica McGrail and Lauren Comegys. Freshmen Courtney Gaskamp and Morgan Lay also made their LT debuts. After a 1st round 295 that put the girls 14 back, they came back and played even better in the 2nd round shooting 291.
