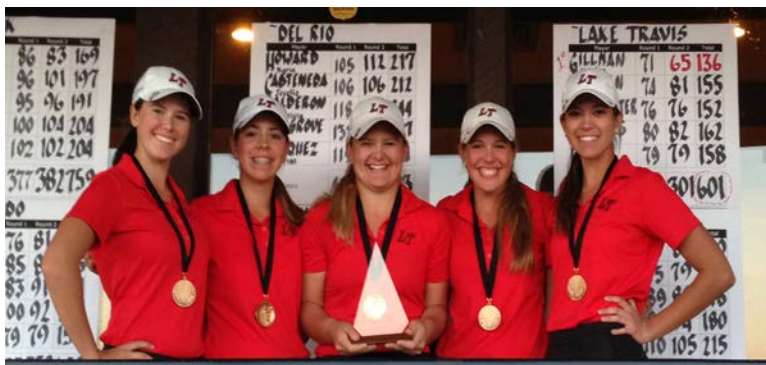




BOYS STATE CHAMPIONS 1997, 2011, 2012, 2013

The Varsity Girls Team of Morgan Lay, Kristen Gillman, Ann Parmerter, Lauren Comegys, and Emily Gillman won the NEISD Tournament of Champions in Kerrville on Monday by a whopping 27 shots! The girls first round score of 300 put them 8 shots clear of Mission Sharyland who finished 6th at last years UIL State Championship. The Cavs pulled away in the 2nd round as other teams faded the Cavs stayed strong and with a team score of 301 they ended well clear of 2nd place Smithson Valley. The girls have done a great job with their physical conditioning over the past few months and that has never been more evident than it was on Monday, 36 holes is lot of golf in one day and handled it without any signs of fatigue. Individually, Kristen Gillman lead the Cavs, her 71-65-136 total gave her a 9 shot victory over solid field. Ann Parmerter finished T5 with rounds of 76-76-152, Emily Gillman was T10 with 74-81-155, Morgan Lay shot 79-79-158 to finish 15th, and Lauren Comegys shot 80-82-162 to finish T21. Additionally, the Cavs sent 3 medalists, with Veronica McGrail firing a career low 75 in the first round followed by an 84 in the second round for a total of 159 and a T16 finish. Courtney "Scooter" Gaskamp fired rounds of 79(also a career low) and 89 for a total of 168 to finish 25th. Emilie Birkvald who moved in from Denmark last month shot 98-87-185 to finish 42nd. Way to go ladies!

Kristen Gillman fired rounds of 71-65 to claim her 5th straight victory.
